



Bruno Vermeire, *Chair of the EU GNSS Security Accreditation Board*

Bruno is currently Head of Information Security at the National Security Authority Belgium. In May 2018, Bruno was appointed as chair of the EU GNSS Security Accreditation Board (SAB). He began his career with the Belgian military in 1980, where he received a military degree in complex telecommunication systems, electronics, programming (computing) and information systems, reaching the rank of Commandant. In 1984 he moved to NATO where he worked as a technical expert in telecoms systems. From 1993 to 2008 he worked with the Military Intelligence and Security Service (Service Général de Renseignement et de Sécurité, SGRS) as Head of the Support and Security Accreditation Unit. In this period he built a wide and profound international recognised experience in securing systems such as highly classified computer networks, airplanes, ships and space application. In 2008 Bruno joined the Belgian NSA.
