Laurent Puzenat holds a degree in Aeronautics, Maintenance and Engineering from the University of Bordeaux. He joined Air France Maintenance in 1991, as an avionic engineer working on aircraft modifications, implementation of new avionic and IFE systems.

In 2003, Laurent joined Air France A380 Entry into Service project. He actively participated in A380 design (on board networks, e-logbook, proposals for new maintenance functions now implemented, connectivity), A380 entry into service preparation and avionic engineering management.

Puzenat joined Air France Flight Operations as an EFB project manager in 2012, working on definition, deployment and evolution of a portable EFB solution on Air France fleets.

Since May 2018, he has been in charge of CNS activities in ATM/SESAR group of Air France Flight Operation, focusing on datalink, ADS-B, aircraft tracking or satellite landing systems.
