
EU Forest Strategy for 2030: the economic, social and environmental functions of forests



- Promoting the multifunctional role of forests
- The contribution of sustainable forest-based bioeconomy to climate-neutrality by 2050 and securing rural livelihoods
- Ensuring that forest ecosystems are restored, resilient, and adequately protected.
- Improved forest monitoring and integrated planning for the future

Monitoring Framework for Resilient European Forests

Objective: Provide a comprehensive picture of the condition of forests in the EU and improve information on climate impacts and risks through collection and sharing of **timely**, **accurate** and **comparable** forest data

How?

- Existing national systems (National Forest Inventories and other national data collection systems)
- 2. Improved and new Copernicus products
- Right balance between remote-sensing data and in situ-data and working towards their integration



Monitoring Framework for resilient EU Forests

Effective and informed decision-making

- **Examples**
- EU Strengthening disaster prevention and risk assessment (EFFIS) and policy implementation (Habitats Directive)
- National Facilitating compliance and reducing administrative burden for MS with smaller capacities (LULUCF)
- Forest Owner Supporting evidence-based planning and management decisions for climate adaptation and resilience


New business opportunities + Digital Agenda for Europe

- Improved access to information on forest in the EU (businesses/public)


International commitments
