What is EUDR?

EUDR aims to combat deforestation and forest degradation

- Deforestation = Conversion of forest to agricultural use (whether human-induced or not)
- Forest degradation = Structural changes to forest cover in the form of
 - primary forests or naturally regenerating forests into plantation forests or into other wooded land
 - primary forests into planted forests

What does it change?

- Operators and traders must prove that imported or sold relevant product in the EU market are deforestation-free
 - → A due diligence statement is required, by collecting data, assessing risks and (if needed) mitigate risks
- Companies need to comply by December 2024 and SME by June 2025
- Failure to comply may lead to penalties or prohibition

Specifications:

- Cut off date: Q1 2021
- Geographical scope: Worldwide
- Traceability: Country/Region of origin, geolocation of plot of production or (if >4 ha) polygons






